

ICSC 2014 GUIDELINE SUBMISSION

- The authors are encouraged to submit the cases through email attachment using Microsoft Word format.
- Cases should be written in English, typed on one side of the A4 paper, 1.5 spaced with a margin of "1 on the left- and 1" on the right hand-side, Times New Roman and font size 12.
- Each case should not exceed 20 pages, excluding teaching notes for case teaching, references, notes, and appendices.
- Do not use all caps for any text.
- Grammar, spelling, and punctuation corrections must be made.
- Please indicate clearly the title of cases, authors' names, institution names, email address for correspondence.
- References APA citation style should be adopted for in-text citations and a reference list.
- Number footnotes consecutively throughout the cases.
- All case studies submitted for the conference must include appropriate signed permissions from case protagonists. Authors must obtain, and submit with their manuscript, written permission to use any and all copyrighted material quoted or reproduced in the case study.
- Every teaching case should be submitted together with teaching notes, and should include the following :
